

One Day Trip: Kuala Lumpur City Tour

Dear participants, on behalf of the Conference Secretariat, we are pleased to invite you to join a technical tour which will be held on 7th November 2018. These are the tentative schedule and programmes:

Itinerary :

0900 Hour

Pick up at hotel lobby, proceed to **King Palace** is the official residence of the Yang di-Pertuan Agong, the monarch of Malaysia. Then, visit to **National Memorial**, a sculpture that commemorates those who died in Malaysia's struggle for freedom, principally against the Japanese occupation during World War II and the Malayan Emergency, which lasted from 1948 until 1960.

1000 Hour

Drive pass to **Parliament House & Lake Garden**. After that, proceed to **National Mosque**, the most distinguished mosque in Kuala Lumpur. It has a unique stylised, star-shaped dome representing the 13 states of Malaysia and the five pillars of Islam. It's 73-metre-high minaret stands impressively against the skyline. Within its beautifully landscaped grounds are pools and fountains. Then, **Former KL Railway Station**.

1100 Hour

After that proceed to **Independence Square**, a square located in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. It is situated in front of the **Sultan Abdul Samad Building**. Then visit to **Kuala Lumpur City Gallery**.

1400 Hour

After Lunch, proceed to **Batu Caves Temple**, one of Kuala Lumpur's most frequented tourist attractions, is a limestone hill comprising three major caves and a number of smaller ones. A limestone outcrop located just north of Kuala Lumpur, Batu Caves has three main caves featuring temples and Hindu shrines. Cathedral Cave – the largest and most popular cavern in Batu Caves – houses several Hindu shrines beneath its 100-metre-high arched ceiling. At the foot of Batu Hill are two other cave temples – the Art Gallery Cave and Museum Cave – which houses numerous Hindu statues and paintings.

1600 Hour

Proceed to a **Kuala Lumpur City Centre (KLCC)**, a multipurpose development area in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The area is located around Jalan Ampang, Jalan P. Ramlee, Jalan Binjai, Jalan Kia Peng and Jalan Pinang. There are a number of shopping complexes such as Suria KLCC and Avenue K. There are also hotels within walking distance such as G Tower, Mandarin Oriental, Grand Hyatt Kuala Lumpur and InterContinental Kuala Lumpur hotel.

1800 Hour

Transfer back to hotel
